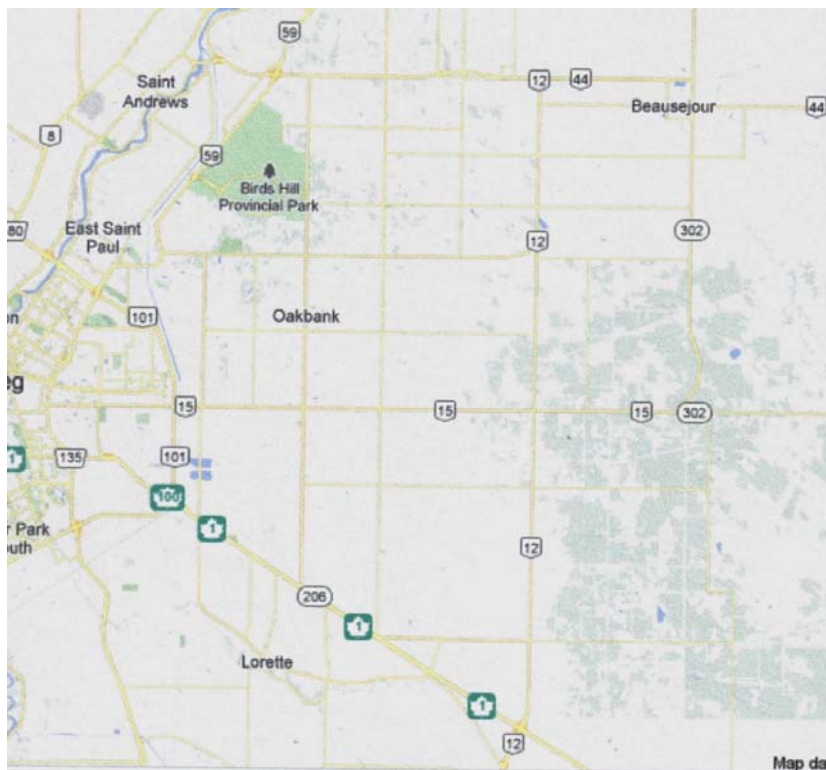
Directions:

GENERAL INFORMATION & TEST RULES

ELIGIBILITY: This test is open to all purebred Dachshunds and those CKC recognized Terriers in Group IV and the Miscellaneous Class list originally bred for or developed for use as earthdogs, Small enough to fit into a 9 inch drain, as listed in Appendix A of The CKC Earthdog Test Rules & Regulations. Dogs must be aged 6 months or older.

ENTRY FEES: per dog per test if received prior to 9:00 PM Aug 24th, 2012

ENTRIES: Entries must be complete, signed and submitted on the official CKC entry form. The order of competing shall be the order that entries are received.

ENTRIES CLOSE: 30 minutes before the scheduled start of class. Entries will automatically close when the following limits have been reached for each test on each day: 20 Introduction to Quarry, 25 Junior and 15 Senior even if the official closing date and time for the entries has not arrived.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test. When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the test secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the test must reach the secretary on or before the date of the test. The test-giving club must refund the entry fee, service charge and listing fee.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY: The receipt of entries will be confirmed for those providing a **return e-mail address** their entry form.

QUARRY: The quarry used in these tests will be 2 adult rats.

GENERAL INFORMATION & TEST RULES

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that Fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to fluctuating currency rates, discounted checks will not be accepted. Personal checks will be accepted. If you pay by personal American check, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Do not write "Payable In Canadian Funds" or "At Par". This will not be acceptable and will not be cleared by the bank. To simplify the process, we urge you to purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds.

Border Crossing: A valid rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require a certificate and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada. Canadian Food Inspection Agency regulations can be viewed at: www.inspection.gc.ca/english/anima/heasan/import/dogse.shtml

Event Registration Number (Foreign Born/Foreign Owned): For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain CKC titles, individual registration is not required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). This number MUST be applied for within 30 days of entering first CKC event to avoid cancellation. Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of dog's foreign Registration Certificate and the appropriate fee along with the completed application form. AWARDS & PRIZES: Qualifiers in Introduction to Quarry Class will receive ribbons. Qualifiers in Junior and Senior classes will receive rosettes. Dogs earning new titles will receive a prize courtesy of Manitoba Dachshund Club.

TEST PRECINCT: It will be West & North of the Buildings. Dogs waiting to be tested shall be kept at least 30.5 m (100 ft.) from the perimeter of the test area in a designated holding area.

REGULATIONS: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be Familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Earthdog Test Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club, (416) 675-5511.

CKC Regulation 15.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an Earthdog test held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities. The Earthdog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating this has occurred.

FOOD: There will be beverages and snacks available for sale at the tests.

RAFFLE: We will be having a raffle table. Please bring donations to support the club.

TEST SITE: Bring water, shade and shelter for you and your dogs. There are some trees at the site for added shade. These tests will run, rain or shine. The site is a private acreage. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during their test. Please pick up after your dogs – there will be garbage bins at the site.
